

# Milk Snakes - cbb

## Care Sheets



**Scientific Name:** Lampropeltistrangulum sp

**Native to:** Depends on species

**Average Length:** 2-6 feet

**Life Span:** 10-15 years



### General Information

Our Milk snakes are captive bred in our facility. Milk snakes make very good pets because they are very easy to care for, and come in a variety of different colors and patterns. Milk snakes are generally docile, curious and gentle. When your milk snake gets ready to shed, the eyes will turn a milky blue and body color will start to become dull and develop a whitish sheen.

### General Care

**Enclosure:** Use a 20 gallon aquarium for your Milk snake. Make sure the snake is no more than twice as long as it's enclosure. Also provide hiding place and branches for the snake to climb on. Don't house milk snakes together or with other snakes or reptiles. Provide a secure enclosure. Milk snakes are known as great escape artists.

**Substrate:** You can use Aspen shavings, mulch-type commercial material, dampened sphagnum moss, bark and pelleted paper.

**Habitat:** Milk snakes love hiding spaces and branches to climb on. Clean cage at least once a week.

**Temperature:** Temperatures should be around 75-85°F. Radiant heat is recommended. Also use incandescent light or ceramic heater as primary heat source and an under tank heat as secondary.

**Lighting:** Milk snakes need 8-12 hours of day of light. Use black or infrared light to view snakes at night.

**Food and Water:** Babies will feed on small pinkie mice. As the Milk snake grows it can eat fuzzy mice and smaller rates. Feed your milk snake frozen/thawed rodents. Milk snake appetites diminish during winter months. Always provide a fresh bowl of water. Milk snakes love to soak in their water, especially before it sheds.
